

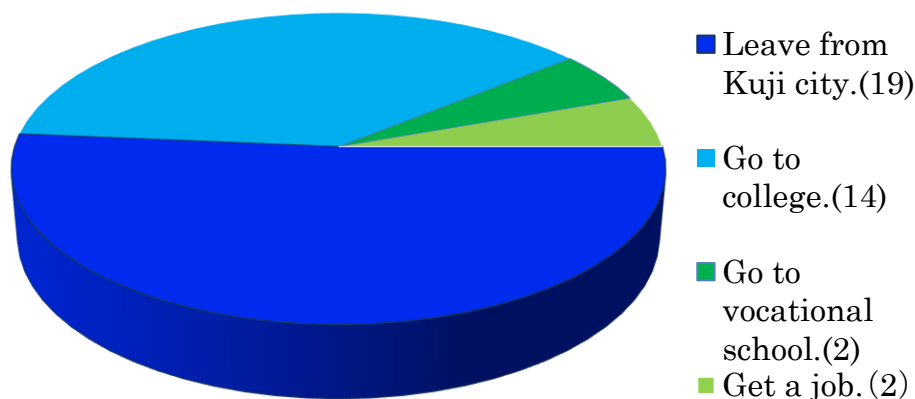
For the Future of Kuji

2. Do you want to get a job in Kuji city?

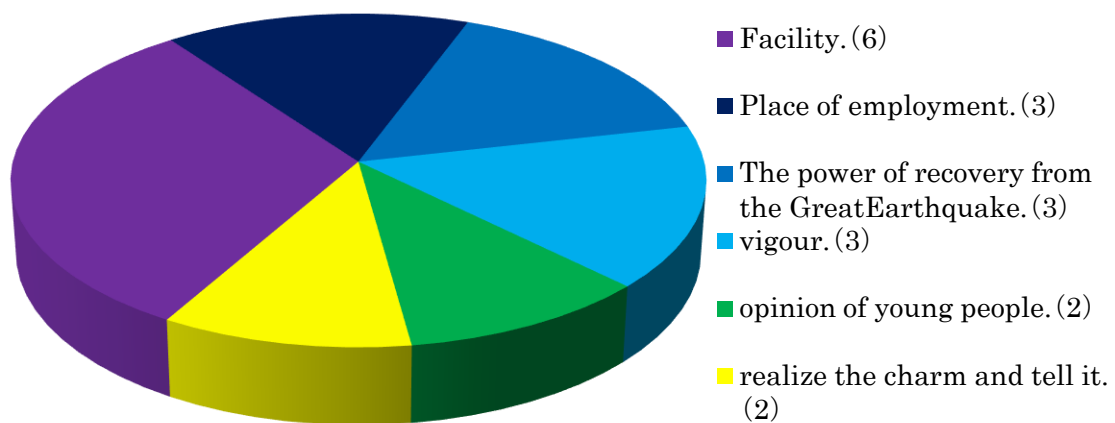


This graph shows whether they want to go back Kuji or not.

And Kuji has a large population of elderly people, so they feel less human energy.

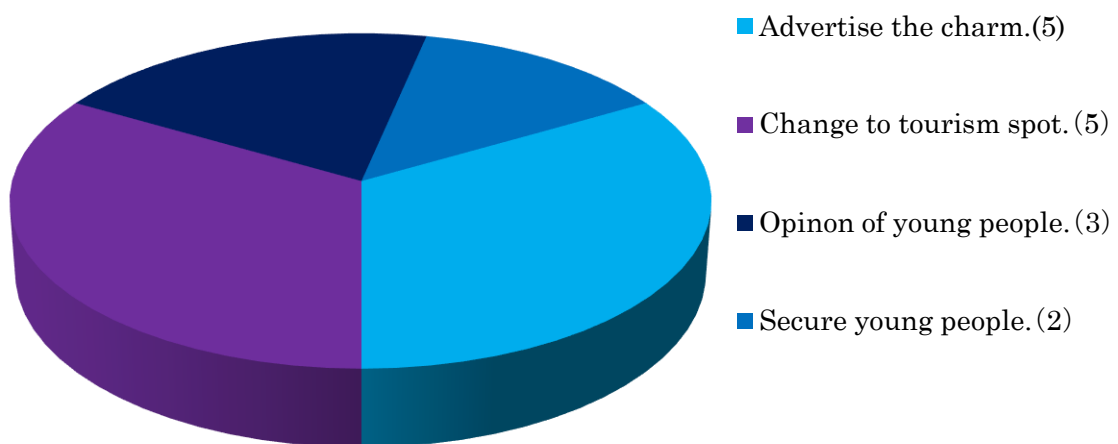
4. What the charm of Kuji city?
