Kenji World

1. Motivation for research

Works of Miyazawa Kenji have been translated into 22 languages, published in many countries and enjoyed all over the world. However, the number of tourists who visit Hanamaki where Kenji was born and grew up in is about 350 thousand people smaller than Tokyo. So we want to research the way that we let tourists visit Hanamaki from Hanamaki airport which has Iwate's only international flight.

2. Hypothesis

As a hypothesis, the reason why the number of tourists is small is that Kenji himself and his works are famous, but its contents and attractive points are not. So we plan to advertise tourist spots where we visited for fieldwork, attract tourists' interests, and connect with increasing of the number of tourist.

3. Sightseeing site

(1) Miyazawa Kenji Fairy Tale Village

There are seven facilities such as "Kenji's School" And "Heavenly Plaza" in the Miyazawa Kenji fairy tale village. Every person can enjoy the view of the world of Kenji.

(2) Miyazawa Kenji Memorial Hall

In Miyazawa Kenji memorial hall, Kenji's personal history, works, and forming that he was absorbed in and so on are introduced. People can enjoy Kenji's activity. If you scan the QR code that is on the display, you can watch the panel which is then translated to English, Chinese, or Korean. There is "Yamanekoken" near the memorial hall. You can eat dishes and buy some goods with enjoying atmosphere of "Yamanekoken."


4. Transportation to Hanamaki

From Morioka Station, the Kaisoku Hamayuri bus takes 45 minutes to Shinhanamaki Station, and Miyazawa Kenji memorial hall is 20 minutes on foot or 5 minutes by bus from there. We have to pay 1,500 yen and use the bus, we have to pay 2,000 yen for round trip.

5. RESAS 1

Graph1 indicates the number of visitors in Iwate by nationality in 2015. It shows that the visitors from Taiwan are the largest. Chinese are the second largest and Americans are the third. From the data, neighboring East Asian countries are the majority of visitors. Thus, it is necessary to invite people from neighboring East Asian countries such as Taiwan and China.



We'll limit our target only on China and Taiwan. Hanamaki has many events in August and September, such as Ihatov Festival and Hanamaki Festival. So, we'll plan some tours in cooperation with these events. And in first place, we must have many people know the name of Kenji and contents of his works.
